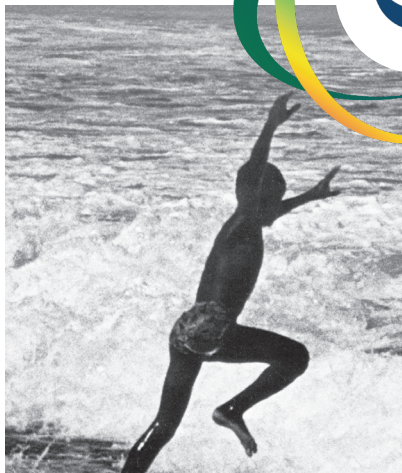

The World Championship in Cooperation (WorldCiC) unites joy and creativity with deeper dimensions of life – it's a process rather difficult to explain, you must simply experience it! Instead of competition the WorldCiC champions cooperate to learn from one another.

The WorldCiC brings forth a special process between children and adults where children are in the lead. Children see the world with new eyes and challenge old habits. Children don't communicate with lectures and reports. They play, dance, sing, dramatize, paint and make shapes out of any material they find.

The WorldCiC moves over the many boundaries of age-, professions-, cultures and nations and children get committed to influence decision makers. More than 30 Mayors have joined the WorldCiC in Stockholm, Sweden 2006 and in Kampala, Uganda 2008. Eleven mayors have started twinning and made bridges between continents and have presented a Promise for the Future to the children. The mayors will report their results in Kuala Lumpur, host of the next WorldCiC 2010.

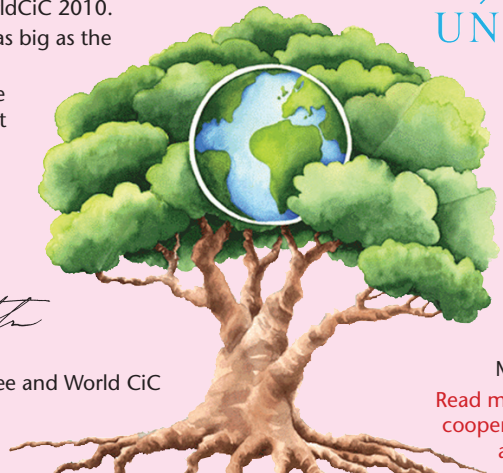
Children dream the WorldCiC will be as big as the Olympics in 2020!

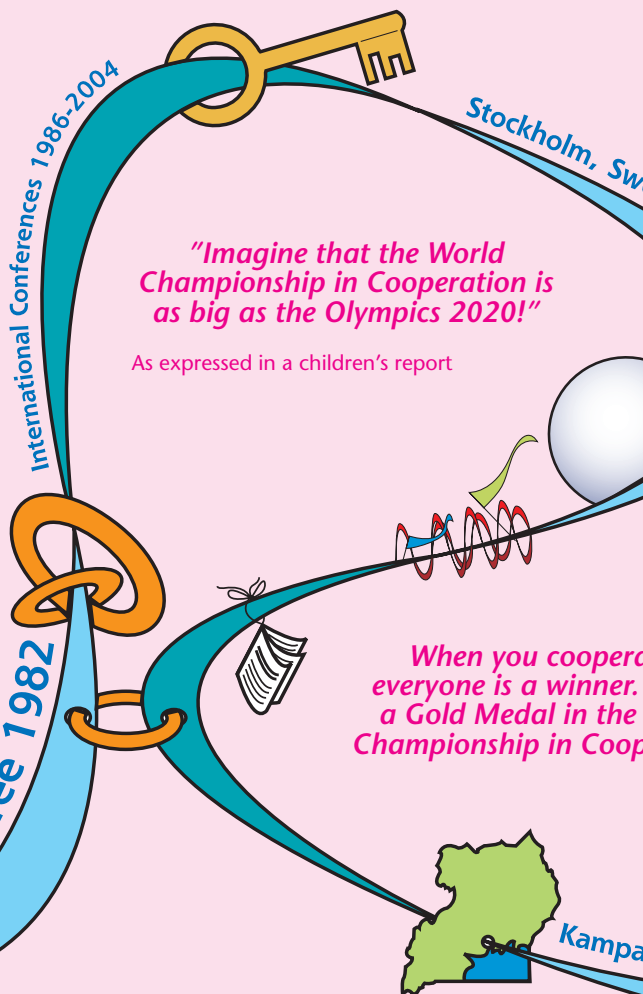

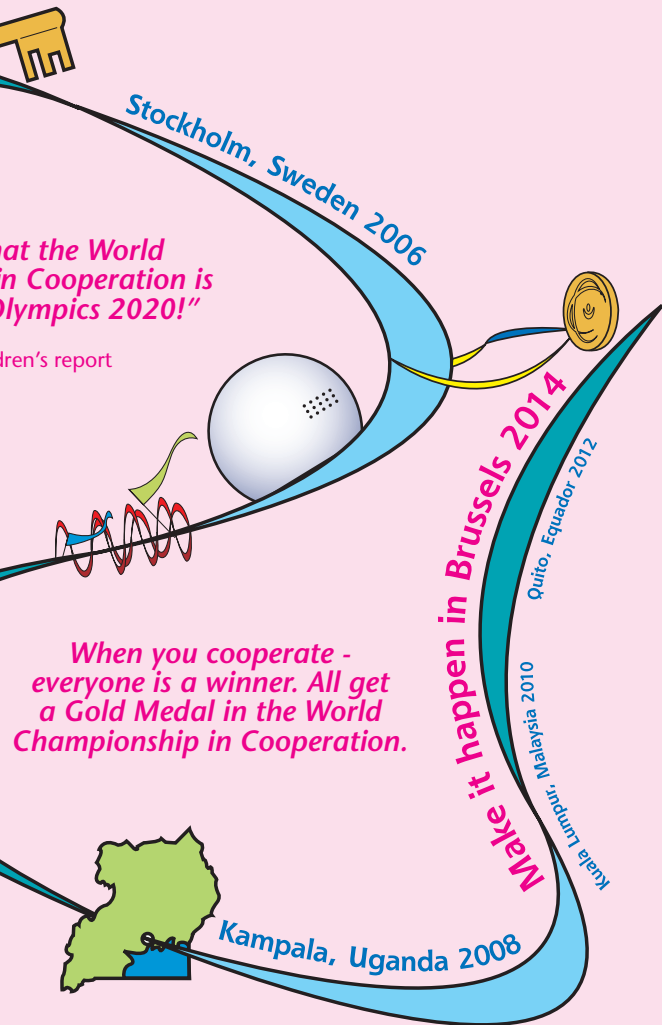
